Ayushman Bharat for a new India -2022

The initiatives under the scheme are as follows:-

Health and Wellness Centre:- The National Health Policy, 2017 has envisioned Health and Wellness Centres as the foundation of India's health system. Under this 1.5 lakh centres will bring health care system closer to the homes of people. These centres will provide comprehensive health care, including for non-communicable diseases and maternal and child health services.

These centres will also provide free essential drugs and diagnostic services. Contribution of private sector through **CSR and philanthropic institutions** in adopting these centres is also envisaged.

National Health Protection Scheme:- The second flagship programme under Ayushman Bharat is National Health Protection Scheme, which will cover over 10 crore poor and vulnerable families (approximately 50 crore beneficiaries) providing coverage upto 5 lakh rupees per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization.

This will be the world's largest government funded health care programme.

Adequate funds will be provided for smooth implementation of this programme.

The these two health sector initiatives under Ayushman Bharat Programme will build a New India 2022 and ensure enhanced productivity, well being and avert wage loss and impoverishment.

These Schemes will also **generate lakhs of jobs, particularly for women.**

In order to further enhance accessibility of **quality medical education** and health care, **24 new Government Medical Colleges and Hospitals** will be set up, by up-grading existing district hospitals in the country. This would ensure that there is at least **1 Medical College for every 3 Parliamentary Constituencies** and at least 1 Government Medical College in each State of the country.

Global Peace Index 2018

The GPI gauges global peace using three broad themes:

- A. **the level of societal safety and security,**
- B. **the extent of ongoing domestic and international conflict**
- C. **the degree of militarization**

Factors are **both internal** such as levels of violence and crime within the country **and external** such as military expenditure and wars.

But it **does not include indicators specifically relating to violence against women and children.**

Rankings in South Asia:

- Region-wise, South Asia experienced the largest increase in peacefulness, with Bhutan, Sri Lanka, India, and Nepal all improving.
 - In the South Asia region, India was ranked lower than Bhutan (19th on the list), Sri Lanka (67), Nepal (84) and Bangladesh (93).
- The only countries which were ranked lower than India in the South Asian region were Pakistan (151 position) and Afghanistan (162)

Index of Industrial Production (IIP)

- The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) is an index for India which details out the growth of various sectors in an economy such as **mineral mining, electricity and manufacturing**.
- The all India IIP is a composite indicator that measures the short-term changes in the volume of production of a basket of industrial products during a given period with respect to that in a chosen base period.
- It is compiled and published monthly by the **Central Statistical Organisation (CSO) six weeks** after the reference month ends.

- Essar Vizag Terminal Ltd (EVTL) has commissioned its iron ore handling complex in Visakhapatnam, deemed to be India's largest, built with an investment of Rs 830 crore.
 - This iron ore handling facility will have the fastest vessel turnaround time for iron ore among Indian ports.
 - The project will help exporters on the east coast benefit **from shorter turnaround times and reduced freight costs.**
 - The facility will support both export and coastal traffic, furthering the vision of the **Sagarmala initiative**
- EVTL took over the project in 2015 on a **Design-Build-Finance-Operate-Transfer** basis for a period of 30 years.
 - The iron ore handling unit is an all-weather, deep draft facility that is equipped to serve the rapidly growing markets of Southeast Asia, including China, Japan, and Korea.
 - It has a dedicated rail connectivity for cargo evacuation from the states of Chhattisgarh, Odisha and Jharkhand.
