Commercial Paper (CP) is an unsecured money market instrument issued in the form of a promissory note.

CPs are short-term instruments and the maturity period varies from seven days to up to one year.

The instrument was introduced in 1990 to enable highly rated corporate borrowers to diversify their sources of short-term borrowings, and also to provide an additional instrument to investors.

CPs can be issued by corporates, primary dealers, and financial institutions. Eligible participants should have a minimum credit rating of A-2 at the time of the issuance of the CP.

Banking companies, mutual funds, other corporate bodies, NRIs, individuals and foreign institutional investors (FIIs) can subscribe to CPs; they are also traded in the secondary market.

Adjacent to the northwest Pacific, which is one of the world's most active basins for typhoons, the Bay of Bengal receives the remnants of major landfalls in the Philippines, China and South Asia.

From these places come low-pressure systems that develop into a monsoon depression or a cyclone.

The reason that cyclones such as Titli, Phailin (2013) and Hudhud (2014) typically strike in October is that wind shear — the difference within wind speeds and direction at two different levels — is low during this time; low wind shear, when combined with surface sea temperatures greater than 26°C, raises the likelihood of cyclones.

In monsoon season, cyclones are rare because of high wind shear.

The National Company Law Tribunal is the Adjudicating Authority for Insolvency resolution process of Companies and Limited Liability Partnerships under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016.

It was established in 1988 by the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) and the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), and later endorsed by the United Nations General Assembly.

Membership is open to all members of the WMO and UN.

The IPCC produces reports that support the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).

The IPCC does not carry out original research, nor does it monitor climate or related phenomena itself.

Rather, it assesses published literature including peer-reviewed and non-peer-reviewed sources.
